

# ORDINANCE NO. <u>2012-18</u>

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA, CHAPTER 17, ARTICLE II. RATES AND CHARGES, SECTION 17-17, RELATING TO ESTABLISHMENT OF WATER RATES SCHEDULE AND ARTICLE II, SECTION 17-18, RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SEWER RATES SCHEDULE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA, that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Phenix City, Chapter 17, ARTICLE II. Rates and Charges, Section 17-17 Relating to the establishment of water rates schedule, be amended as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA, that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Phenix City, Chapter 17, Article II, Section 17-18 relating to the establishment of sewer rates schedule, be amended as shown on Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

If any part of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional, it should not automatically void the remaining sections.

# SCHEDULE OF WATER SERVICE RATES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA

# **SECTION 17-17** – ESTABLISHMENT OF WATER RATE SCHEDULE

The following schedule of rates and regulations regarding the furnishing of water and sewer from the water system of the City is hereby established and declared to be effective upon passage, approval and adoption by the City Council of the City of Phenix City:

## METER RATES FOR WATER

Subject to the minimum charges herein after set forth, the following shall be the schedule of monthly charges for water furnished from the water system:

All fees will be based on the size of the water meter.

Cost associated with connections larger than 3" will be determined after a field investigation and shall include labor and materials.

Plus a minimum charge of \$200.00 for breaking pavement, additional charges for cuts longer than 15 feet may apply.

For meter sizes greater than 10" the price shall be determined through an analysis of projected needs for the customer involved.

## METER SET AND/OR METER PIT

In cases where, at the time when application for water service is made, the service installation has been completed with the exception of the meter setting or meter setting and pit, and supply

lines have been installed to such an extent that the meter can be set in the proper location, the charges for completing the meter and /or meter pit setting shall be:

## **METER RESET CHARGE**

In cases where, the service installation has been completed with the exception of the meter setting or meter setting and pit, and supply lines have been installed to such an extent that the meter can be set and a request is made to move or reset the location of the water meter, the charges for completion of the service installation shall be:

#### SERVICE FEE

Each new customer requesting garbage, water or sewer service from the system (regardless of whether the premises to which service is to be furnished had been previously connected with the system), shall pay to the City a connection fee to cover the cost of adding the customer to the system Fees for connection shall be:

Water & Sewer	\$75.00

Sewer Only	\$60.00	
Garbage Only	\$20.00	
Sprinkler System	\$35.00	

#### SPECIAL WATER SERVICE

## **Private Fire Protection**

As consideration for the willingness of the City to provide standby water service for private fire protection, annual charges for provision of such services shall be as set forth herein below. Such charges shall be applicable where water is supplied to fire lines and/or sprinkler systems for fire protection purposes only, and under the following conditions:

- (1) The fire flow supply line is separate from any other water lines entering the establishment:
- (2) There are no cross-connections between fire protection and potable water systems with the establishment;
- (3) The fire flow supply line entering the establishment is not metered, and;
- (4) An approved backflow preventer is installed in the fire flow supply line entering the establishment.

#### BEAUTIFICATION PROJECTS IN SUBDIVISION COMMON AREAS

In common areas for beautification projects the water tap fee will be reduced one-half of the listed costs of each size meter and the breaking pavement charge will not be added to the cost of the tap if the following conditions are met:

- (1) The project must be located in an R-1 zone and place in common areas of the subdivision and it must be for beautification projects only. Beautification shall mean any addition of shrubbery or grasses that require water on a continued basis for growth.
- (2) The tap application must be placed in the name of a responsible homeowner who agrees to be charged for the tap application fee, the deposit, the monthly water charges and any additional charges incurred.

# SCHEDULE OF SEWER SERVICE RATES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA

# **SECTION 17-18 – SANITARY SEWER CHARGES**

A) Sewer Usage: The sewer usage fee shall be based on all water usage.

Sewer Usage Fees are as follows:

Per 1,000 Gallons of Water Usage	\$ 3.36
Minimum Charge	\$10.08
Maximum Residential Charge	\$33.60

There will be no Maximum Charge for Commercial or Industrial Use.

B) Sewer Tap Fees Where City Installs Tap: Taps will be based on the size of the water meter.

Costs associated for larger taps will be determined after a field investigation and shall include labor and materials.

Plus a minimum charge of \$200.00 for breaking pavement, additional charges for cuts longer than 15 feet may apply.

C) Connection Fee Where Tap is Pre-stubbed By Developer:

Taps will be based on the size of the water meter.

Cost associated with larger connections will be determined after a field investigation and shall include labor and materials.

For meter sizes greater than 10" the price shall be determined through an analysis of projected needs for the customer involved.

The following service charges will be assessed only if the problem is determined to be a plumbing malfunction on the customer's property.
