Steps to Cleaner Water

AT HOME

- Wash your car on the lawn and not the driveway.
 This will help prevent detergents from washing into storm drains.
- Repair radiator and oil leaks.
- Use non-toxic cleaners and polishes.
- Do not rinse paintbrushes or other tools into stormwater drains.

- Avoid washing grass and yard clippings into the storm inlet. The excessive nutrients could affect the oxygen levels in water.
- Sweep driveways and sidewalks rather than washing them into storm drains.
- Have your pool backwash into the sewer and not the stormwater drain.
- Keep septic tanks properly maintained and have them pumped every 3 to 5 years.

Properly use and store fertilizers and pesticides.

IN THE COMMUNITY
