- MEDIA VANS MAY PARTICIPATE ONLY BY PULLING FLOATS. IF THE VAN IS EQUIPPED WITH A PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM IT MAY ONLY PLAY PATRIOTIC MUSIC.
- CONVERTIBLES MAY NOT EXCEED 3 RIDERS AND ONE DRIVER AND MUST BE DECORATED IN A PATRIOTIC NATURE.
- <u>ALL</u> UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES PARKED IN THE PARADE LINE-UP AREA WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS!</u>
- NO HORSES, NO VENDORS.
