Phenix City Submits 2017-2018 Annual Storm Water Report

The City of Phenix City has submitted their 2017-2018 Storm Water Management Program Annual Report to the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM).

What is the Annual Report?

As a Phase II city and a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer (MS4) permittee, Phenix City is required to submit a report to ADEM describing the actions occurring during the previous reporting period.

The Annual Report documents the implementation of the activities in our Storm Water Management Program (SWMP) for the previous year, evaluates the effectiveness of those strategies, and allows us to plan for any changes needed to better our storm water program.

Why is the Annual Report necessary?

Aside from providing documentation to satisfy the requirements of ADEM and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the report also provides the means to communicate the status of our program with the community. It allows citizens to view the resources dedicated to protecting our waterways.

What information is included in the Annual Report?

The report includes a narrative, tables, maps, standard operating procedures, construction forms, educational materials, certifications, water monitoring and rainfall data, and examples of permitting, inspection, and enforcement documents used by the City.
