Resolution in reference to the Compensation and Benefits Agreement between the City of Phenix City and City Manager Wallace B. Hunter, was approved.

Resolution in reference to authorizing and directing the Mayor, City Manager, and Police Chief to sign an MOU Agreement with Central Alabama Crimestoppers, was approved.

Resolution in reference to accepting a permanent drainage easement on Lot 24, Section One, Saddlebrook lying in Section 33, Township 18 North, Range 30 East, Phenix City, Lee County, Alabama, was approved.

Resolution in reference to accepting a proposal from J C Construction to construct parking spaces for the Police Precinct on 5<sup>th</sup> Street South in an amount not to exceed \$16,301.25, was approved.
