

RESOLUTION NO. 2021- 174

WHEREAS, the 2019 Alabama Legislature has passed Act 2019-2 which levied an additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Phenix City will receive a portion of said tax which will be deposited into a separate fund; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be solely dedicated to the maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads as mandated by Act 2019-2; and

WHEREAS, the City will adopt an Annual Transportation Plan no later than August 31, 2021 and will implement during the next fiscal year based on an estimate of revenues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Phenix City, Alabama intends to utilize funding from Act 2019-2 for Preliminary Engineering and Construction activities associated with the resurfacing of 4th Place from Knowles Road to Seale Road, Knowles Road from 16th Avenue to 4th Place, 43rd Street from Summerville Road to the End and the Replacement of the Bridge over Cochagalechee Creek on Seale Road. The City's total estimated obligation for Preliminary Engineering and Construction for these projects is \$422,005.55 of which 10 Cent Gas Tax funds will be utilized with any remaining balance be carried forward or used for cost overruns.

RE: Annual Transportation Plan – Ten (10) Cent Gas Tax

In 2019, the Alabama Legislature passed Act 2019-2 which levied an additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel (Ten (10) Cent Gas Tax). This additional tax is to be used for maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads and bridges that are maintained by the City. It is estimated that the City will receive \$192,785 from the additional Ten (10) Cent Gas Tax in FY 2021/22 and we currently have \$271,000 in the account from the previous years.

The City has previously stated that we would use these funds to resurface Dobbs Drive. We have determined that it will be more cost efficient for the City to use our current Roadway Improvements Bid to resurface Dobbs Drive; therefore, we will use funds from the Capital Improvement Budget.

Since projects that utilize these funds have to meet ALDOT requirements, we plan to use the funds as the City's 20% match for the preliminary engineering and construction for the below MPO projects.

- Resurface 4th Place from Knowles Road to Seale Road
- Resurface Knowles Road from 16th Avenue to 4th Place
- Resurface 43rd Street from Summerville Road to the end
- Replace the Bridge over Cochagalechee Creek on Seale Road

The total estimated cost to the City for Preliminary Engineering and Construction for all four of these projects is \$422,005.55. The estimated total amount of funds in the Ten (10) cent gas tax fund account is expected to be \$463,785 at the end of FY 21/22. The remaining funds in the account will be carried forward or will be used for cost overruns on the above listed projects. The attached resolution states this information and is considered the Transportation Plan that must be approved.

RE: Annual Transportation Plan - 10 Cent Gas Tax

On March 12, 2019, the Alabama Legislature passed House Bill 2 which levied an additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel (10 Cent Gas tax). This additional tax is to be used for maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads and bridges that are maintained by the City. The Bill further stipulates that the funds must be deposited into a separate account and shall be used solely for improvements designated by the City's Annual Transportation Plan as defined in HB2.

It is estimated that the City will receive \$151,448 from the additional 10 Cent Gas tax in FY20/21. The City plans to rehabilitate/resurface Dobbs Drive for a total estimated cost of \$500,000 which includes \$151,448 of FY 20/21 10 Cent Gas tax, \$141,067 of FY 19/20 10 Cent Gas tax and \$207,485 of existing gas tax funds. The attached resolution states this information and is considered the Transportation Plan that must be approved


WHEREAS, the City will adopt an Annual Transportation Plan no later than August 31, 2019 and implemented during the next fiscal year based on an estimate of revenues.





REMINDER: Rebuild Alabama Act

Annual Transportation Plan

While receipt of distributions is not tied to any report or plan, the Rebuild Alabama Act (Act 2019-2) requires municipalities to adopt, by majority vote of the council, an annual transportation plan "no later than **August 31** for the next fiscal year."

The plan itself must provide "a detailed list of projects for which expenditures are intended to be made in the next fiscal year" based on an estimate of the revenues from the fund. Once adopted, the plan must be all times be posted at city hall and if a municipality has an official website, on the website. The Act does not require that this transportation plan be submitted to any agency or department of the state.

Bid Posting for Rebuild Alabama Act Projects

Additionally, the Act requires that for all municipal projects, the appropriate plans and bid opening date shall be published in electronic form no later than the 10th day of the month preceding the bid opening on a website maintained for that purpose by the Alabama League of Municipalities.

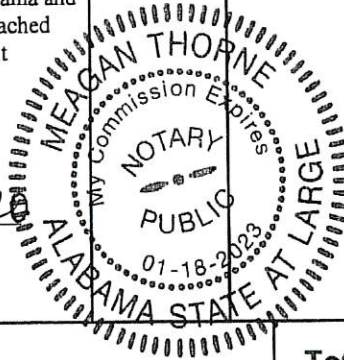
