# **JOB SUMMARY**

Under general supervision, this position is responsible for planning daily maintenance schedules of all irrigation at Lakewood Golf Course to include preventative maintenance and repairs. Position may assist in other areas of maintenance as required including mowing.

The following duties are normal for this position. - Repair or replace damaged irrigation heads
- Repair irrigation lines, in sizes up to 6 inches
- Preventative maintenance on irrigation heads and irrigation systems
- Re-build or replace irrigation station components including heads, decoders, solenoids and valves.
- Assist in course maintenance to include mowing, raking bunkers, trimming limbs and shrubbery, debris clean-up and other areas of landscape maintenance
