WORK SESSION MEETING MINUTES May 17, 2021

The members of the City Council of the City of Phenix City, Alabama met at 3:00 p.m. Eastern Time for the regularly scheduled work session on Monday, May 17, 2021, by the way of Zoom Video Conferencing. Upon roll call, the following members were present by the way of Zoom Video Conferencing: Councilmember Arthur L. Councilmember Bailey led the invocation.

Mayor Lowe advised there were no Requests to Address Council.
