## WORK SESSION MEETING MINUTES May 20, 2024

City Manager Wallace Hunter stated that a flyer regarding what are flushable and what needs to be trashed will be sent out to all citizens in their water bill statements. Mr. Hunter reviewed the information in the letter. Mr. Hunter stated that these issues are costing the City's Utilities Department millions of dollars over time to unclog the City's pipes. Utilities Director John Spraggins provided an overview of the types of items that are causing the issues in the pipes. Mr. Spraggins informed Mayor and Council of what happens when grease goes down the drains and the damage it causes. Councilmember Day inquired as to how many times the flyer will be sent out to citizens. Mr. Spraggins stated that they send them out once a year.
