WORK SESSION MEETING MINUTES September 30, 2024

Upon a quorum being established, Mayor Lowe called the meeting to order.

Mayor Lowe led the invocation.

Mayor Lowe advised there were no Request to Address Council.

Councilmember Bailey inquired if cuts in town had been checked for wash outs after the storm that Phenix City just had. City Engineer Angel Moore stated that staff is checking on them and have only found one that is washed out thus far. Ms. Moore also stated that staff is still concerned with the river walk flooding issues.

Councilmember Bailey mentioned an email that Mayor Lowe had received from a concerned patron in regards to certain parts of Phenix City still looking the same as it did years

ago with an emphasis on Seale Road and the lack of businesses located there. Councilmember Bailey stated how much the gentlemen's comments bothered him and that they were just not true as he explained how he drove around Phenix City over the last couple of days and noticed the work taking place all over the City and that it is not just in one concentrated area. City Manager Wallace Hunter stated that too much valuable time is being wasted on complaints from people who do not even reside in Phenix City. Mr. Hunter also stated that the City is broken up into three districts and that staff does their due diligence to make sure there is a project or job taking place in all three of those districts simultaneously.

Councilmember Day inquired if the City has the keys to the building in Austin Sumbry Park or if staff is still working on it. City Manager Wallace Hunter explained that the building is under an agreement that seems to be a part of the separate portion of the park. Mr. Hunter stated that the current contract is good until December, 2024, but plans are in place.

Councilmember Day stated that he had a gentlemen contact him in regards to all the used tires and trash left out by the road near Mother Mary Mission. Engineering Director Angel Moore explained that it is not the City's responsibility to clean up the trash pile at a business and stated that if the City does it for them they will have to do it for everyone else. Ms. Moore explained in detail what the process is to have extra trash picked up.

Parks and Recreation Director Todd Hughes stated that he and staff are doing their due diligence with the ant problem that they are experiencing at the Lakewood Ball Park and Idle Hour Park and that he was aware of the complaints that were being received.

Assistant City Manager Chan Gamble stated that the worker's at Alatrade are discharging chicken bones in the sewer system and went on to speak about other issues and problems Alatrade has been having. Mr. Gamble also stated that Utilities Director John Spraggins talked with Alatrade in April, 2024 to have them go to the lift stations, drain and clean them out of all the debris. Mr. Spraggins also provided details on what the workers have to go through just to get to the bottom of the lift which is 40 feet down. City Manager Wallace Hunter stated that the City is already short staffed in that department and having to deal with this issue is a lot on the staff.

Mayor Lowe stated that there being nothing further to discuss, the meeting adjourned until 3:00 p.m. on October 15, 2024.
